

2010 TOURNAMENT PITCHING RULES

A tournament pitcher is allowed to pitch:

MINOR **NO MORE THAN** three (3) innings or 75 pitches in one calendar day (whichever comes first) or
NO MORE THAN eight (8) innings or 200 total pitches in a week

COACHES PITCH **NO MORE THAN** one (1) inning in one calendar day.

PONYTAIL **NO MORE THAN** one (1) inning in one calendar day.

Pitcher who pitches in more than one game on the same calendar day may pitch any combination of innings in those games provided they do not pitch on more than the above stated rule permits.

In these tournaments, a pitcher is allowed to pitch in **NOT MORE THAN**:

MINOR three (3) innings or 75 pitches in one calendar day or eight (8) innings or 200 total pitches in a week.

COACHES PITCH 2 total inning

PONYTAIL 2 total inning

Names of all pitchers actually appearing in a game, along with the number of innings pitched, will be recorded on the "TOURNAMENT PITCHING RECORD". The manager of the OPPOSING team will sign this form and turn it into the CONCESSION STAND after each game. At the beginning of each game, all managers will be given a TOURNAMENT PITCHING RECORD to verify pitching stats.

Pitcher eligibility will be posted on the CONCESSION STAND WINDOW along with division playing brackets before the start of every game.

VIOLATION OF ANY PITCHING RULE WILL RESULT IN AN AUTOMATIC FORFEIT OF THE GAME.
